Day 1	★ Bangkok ★ Siem Reap ★ Museum ★ Angkor Thom ★
Morning	Departure to Siem Reap by Bangkok Airways Flight Arrive at Siem Reap Airport, meet tour guide at airport
	 
	Then visit the Angkor National Museum www.angkornationalmuseum.com , Visitors will develop a deeper understanding of the historical and cultural involvement, including the religions and beliefs of the ancient khmer Empire. for check in at hotel.
Noon	Lunch at Selantra Restaurant.
Afternoon	Visit to Southern Gate of Angkor Thom then visit to The Bayon temple stands at the center of the city. Built at the end of the 12 th century by King Jayavarman VII. The giant sculpted faces represent Jayavarman VII in his divine state. The faces are looking to the four cardinal points. Terrace of the Elephants & Terrace of the Leper King , built by King Jayarman VII
Evening	Dinner at FCC Restaurant. Then transfer to Hotel.

Day 2	★ Grand Circuit ★ Ta Prohm ★ Angkor Wat ★ Phnom Bakeng
	 
Morning	Breakfast at hotel. Visit the highlights of the grand circuit, including Pre Rup , was built in the late 10th century. Pre Rup is a temple with some nicely carved doors and from the top of the temple there is a great view of the surrounding area. Visit Eastern Mebon , guarded at its corner by stone figures of harnessed elephants, some of which are still in a reasonable state of preservation. Visit Neak Poan , a fountain built in the middle of a pool. Visit Preah Khan , Buddhist temple built by King Jayavarman VII to honor his dead father is located in the town where the king routed the Chams.
Noon	Lunch at local restaurant
Afternoon	Visit Jungle-clad Ta Prohm . Buddhist monastery, with overgrow fig and silk-cotton tree roots intertwining the ruins, and then go visit magnificent Angkor Wat , This temple was built in the early to mid 12 th century. Suryavarman II constructed Angkor Wat into a huge temple like mountain with 5 huge towers, which can be seen from afar and was dedicated to the Hindu God and Vishnu.
Evening	Dinner with Traditional Dance at Amazon Restaurant.

Then transfer back to hotel.

Day 3 ★ Bantey Srei ★ War Museum ★ Bantey Samre ★ Les Artisan d'Angkor ★ Bangkok ★



Morning

Breakfast at hotel.

Visit **Bantey Srei**, stands alone in the quality of its construction and decoration its pink sandstone walls are decorated with what some consider the best carvings of all, and still an amazing state of preservation. Built in 967 A.D and dedicated to Brahma, and **Akira War Museum** on the way back, for deeper understanding of the land mine problem in Cambodia. Then visit **Banteay Samre**, with elaborate architecture and exceptional carvings, constructed around the same time as Angkor Wat, the similar style is particular is obvious in the balustrades carvings of Hindu sense are in excellent conditions.

Lunch at local restaurant.

Afternoon

Visit **Chantiers Ecoled - Les Artisans d'Angkor**, learn and discover to Khmer silk in Silk Farm, the school of silk handmade. See and shop with freedom choice at Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecoles, school of caving. Catch up on last-minute. Shopping in **Old market** and prepare for departure.

Surprisingly with its patient perfect carved, this temple said to be build by women in that period as have been proved with its name called **Banteay Srei** meaning " The Citadel of Women "

visit the old town of King Jayavarman VII, the famous and powerful king in the late of 12th century. The city is called **Angkor Thom**, the town of Khmer including the temple such as: **South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon Temple complex, Terraces of Elephants , Terrace of Leper King and Former Royal Palace**. In the afternoon continue to visit the temple of **Ta Prohm**, the only one temple which has been kept its first natural situation, to be the example of how most of the temples of Angkor would look like at the time of discovering

13.00 Lunch at a local restaurant

Afternoon dedicated to visit the most famous & magnificent **Angkor Wat temple**. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. With many galleries with columns, libraries, pavillions, courtyards and ponds full of water, carved bas-reliefs about Ramayana Story and day-to-day life at the time of Angkor's construction

16.30 Enjoy visiting and walking to the top of **Phnom Bakheng Mountain** until time watching sunset which is the best view of sunset in Angkor area on the 65-meter high top. It was built in 10th century by King – Jacovarman I. Once used as an observation post by the Cambodian army, the site has suffered a lost. Most people to there for sunset with spectacular views over Angkor Wat

18.30 Dinner at a local restaurant

19.45 Back to the hotel. Overnigt at the hotel
