

Exploring Yangon 3 Days 2 Nights

Yangon – Kyaikhtiyo-Bago-Yangon

Valid from 01 October 2012- 01 January 2013



Day 1 ★ Bangkok ★ Yangon ★ Bago ★ Swemawdaw Pagoda ★ Kanbawzathadi Palace★Kyaiktiyo★

07.15 am. Check in at Suvarnaphoum Airport, Gate 4 Low F of Bangkok Airways.

09.15 am. Departure to Yangon by Bangkok Airways Flight by

10.05 am. Arrive **Yangon International Airport**, to meet our representative and direct to Hongsawaddy (1.30 hour), on the way pass **Htaukkyant World War II Cemetery** where 27,000 allied soldiers who had perished during the Second World War were buried.



Visit an over 1200 year-old, and most sacred Pagoda in Hongsawaddy, **Swemawdaw Pagoda**. It was reconstructed with 125 meters high, after being ruined by the earthquake in 1930. Then visit **Kanbawzathadi Palace**, the palace site of King Bayinnaung who is the founder of Myanmar 2nd Dynasty.

Noon Lunch at local restaurant.

Afternoon **Drive to Kyaikhtiyo** - the largest domestic tourism center located about 168 km from Yangon to visit the mystical pagoda named Golden Rock Pagoda stands on a gold gilded boulder, precariously perched on the edge of a hill over 1100 m above sea level. There are many legends about the pagoda and Nats (Spirit gods) shrines along the 11 km uphill hike from the base camp climbed by local open trucks (non roof, non aircon). Coaches reach only at Kinpun base camp. Proceed to Yathe Taung base camp, which is located on the half way and about 45 minutes drive from Kinpun base camp and only 2 km uphill trek to the summit.

Evening Dinner at hotel & overnight at hotel in Kyaikhtiyo.

Day 2 Kyaiktiyo ★ Bago ★ Shwethalyaung Pagoda ★ Kyaikpun Pagoda ★ Yangon★



05.00 am See the monk and offering food. **And back to hotel for breakfast.**
 After breakfast return to Sightseeig Bago(approx 3 hrs). Visit **Shwethalyaung Pagoda** a huge reclining Buddha built during 9th century and Mons' weaving village.

Noon **Lunch at local restaurant.**

Afternoon Visit **Kyaikpun Pagoda**, it is not a pagoda, in true sense of the word, but rather a "temple" comprising huge four images of different Buddhas facing the cardinal directions. They sit back to back against a massive brick pillar. They represent Gautama Buddha (facing north), Konagamana (south), Kakusandha (east) and Kassapa (west).
 Visit **Shwedagon Pagoda**, a spectacular golden sacred memorial, which was established more than 2500 years ago and preserving eight pieces of the Buddha's hair buried deep under its base. The pure golden top of the pagoda where was decorated by donated jewelry, including diamonds,is a highlight of this holy place, especially in the night time. It is also a chance to be part of Myanma's tradition which allows you to water the Buddha statues of your day of birth for luck and happiness.

Evening **Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Yangon.**

Day 3 **Yangon★ Bangkok**



Morning After breakfast visit to **Sule Pagoda** located on a roundabout in downtown Yangon. It is said to be over 2,000 years old and contains a hair given by the Buddha to two Burmese merchants. The golden pagoda is unusual in that its octagonal shape continues right up to the bell and inverted bowl.
 Visit to **Kabaaye (World Peace) Pagoda**; Mahapassana Cave where the Buddihist Synods are held and visit to **Loka Chantha Abhavyalabhamuni Buddha image** **Kyauk Daw Gyi Buddha Image** (world largest marble image) which is being carved from over 600 tons white marble rock of 37 feet long and and **Tooth Relice Pagoda.**

Noon **Lunch at local restaurant.**

Afternoon After lunch for Shopping at **Bogyoke Market** used to be called Scott Market – the largest market in Yangon with tiem to browse among the hundreds of stalls for souvenir bargains.

15.00 pm. Transfer to international airport for check in.
17.40 pm. Depart by Bangkok Airways **PG 704.**
19.05 pm. Arrive at Suvarnabhumi airport.

You can obtain a visa from Myanmar Embassies in the various countries. The international points of entry and exit in Myanmar are Yangon International Airport.

Requirement for visa application

Passport valid for at least 6 months, 3 passport-size photos. A copy of identity card/Passport with owner signature. Work permit guaranty.
